Sisters & Brothers Together All Year Long!

What do you remember from your childhood? Do you recall a special memory with your siblings? Blowing out birthday candles, playing tag, baking cookies, riding bikes, welcoming home your first puppy?

Just like you, children who experience foster care cherish their sibling relationships. However, once they enter the foster care system over 75% are separated from one another and do not see one another on a regular basis. The result: Their health and well-being are compromised. Many kids worry about one another, miss each other, and feel the impact of being removed from their homes and placed in foster care.

Sibling Connections is a non-profit organization that has created a solution. We make it possible for brothers and sisters to stay connected all year long. With the help of generous volunteers, donors, sponsors, and foundations, we provide children across the Commonwealth with two programs: Camp To Belong Massachusetts and Sibling Sundays.

This summer we celebrated our sixth season of Camp To Belong MA. Children from all over the state came together with our fabulous volunteer counselors and spent the week creating joyous shared memories. They spent time together swimming and boating in the lake, scaling the climbing wall, swinging from the

trapeze, playing in the pool, and riding their favorite horses.



Signature Camp to Belong activities such as sibling pillows, our campwide Birthday Party, Carnival Night, Talent Show, and Campfires were woven into the week as well. Everyone had a wonderful time! CTB MA campers and counselors alike left the Berkshires

with wonderful keepsakes supplied by our generous partners from Beaver Summer Programs: sleeping bags, pillows, flashlights, beach towels and duffle bags. Cradles to Crayons donated a brand new backpack full of school supplies to each sibling.

After camp ended, CTB MA campers went back to school and we began preparing for our sixth season of Sibling Sundays in western Massachusetts. We planned our third season of Sibling Sundays in southeastern MA. Then we prepared to launch a new monthly program in the Greater Lowell area.

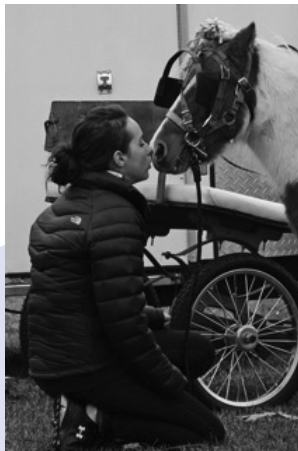
Please help us bring sisters and brothers together all year long. Our organization needs your help to be healthy and vibrant for the kids. Thank you for your time and consideration!
